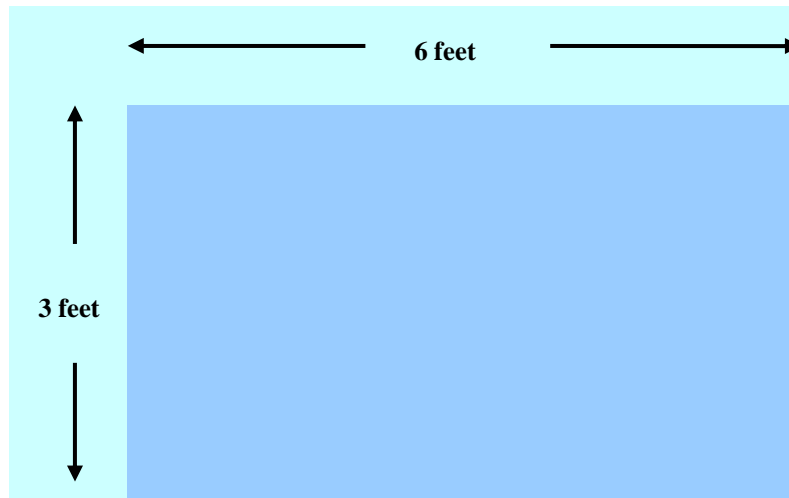


Guide for Poster Presentations

A poster presentation is a graphically oriented summary of your research project.

Each presenter will have a net useable space in portrait/vertical format that measures 6 feet wide x 3 feet high in which to exhibit their poster.



- The boards will be numbered, and each presenter will be assigned a spot. Please check the poster list on Board #1 in the 6th floor Auditorium Lounge.
- Posters should be set up between 8am and 9am on Thursday, May 15, 2008, and remain on display for the duration the workshop until 4:30pm. Posters left after 5:30pm on that date will be removed by workshop staff.
- Poster mounting supplies (Velcro strips) will be supplied at the workshop. Staples, pins, and double-sided tape are NOT allowed.
- You may also wish to bring along 20 copies of your summary or abstract to distribute (be sure to include your complete mailing address and email if you wish additional comments).
- Please stand by your poster between 10:30am and 11am to talk with the viewers and to get feedback.
